Notes regarding the instructions

Symbols



Warning of electrical voltage

Safety

Read this manual carefully before starting or using the device. Always store the manual in the immediate vicinity of the device or its site of use.



Warning

Read all safety warnings and all instructions. Failure to follow the warnings and instructions may result in electric shock, fire and/or serious injury. **Save all warnings and instructions for future reference.**

This appliance can be used by children aged from 8 years and above and persons with reduced physical, sensory or mental capabilities or lack of experience and knowledge if they have been given supervision or instruction concerning use of the appliance in a safe way and understand the hazards involved. Children shall not play with the appliance. Cleaning and user maintenance shall not be made by children without supervision.

- Do not open the device housing. There is danger of a short circuit.
- Keep device away from open fire and hot surfaces and do not store or operate it in their vicinity.
- Do not pull the power cable directly out of the socket; always hold on to the mains plug itself.
- Do not leave the device running unattended.
- Insert the mains plug into a properly fused mains socket.
- Allow the device to cool down before transport and/or maintenance work.
- Do not use the device in aggressive atmosphere.
- Do not use the device in potentially explosive rooms or areas and do not install it there.
- Do not use the device with wet or damp hands.


The device is equipped with bright surface LEDs and an overheating protection. The device has an on/off switch.

The LED light and the transport handle can be adjusted by up to 360° .

For operation, the device's power cable is connected to a mains socket.



Transport and storage

Transport

To make the device easier to transport, it is fitted with a carry handle.


Before transporting the device, observe the following:

- Switch the device off.
- Allow the device to cool down.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.

Storage

Before storing the device, proceed as follows:

- Switch the device off.
- Allow the device to cool down.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.
- Clean the device as described in the Maintenance chapter.
- Loosen the two locking screws (3) and pull the transport handle (1) down onto the foot (6) to fold up the device.



When the device is not being used, observe the following storage conditions:

- dry and protected from frost and heat
- ambient temperature below 50 °C
- protected from dust and direct sunlight

Unpacking the device

• Take the device out of the packaging.



Adjusting the lighting position


Please proceed as follows to adjust the lighting position:

- 1. If necessary, switch the device off by setting the on/off switch (7) to position **0**.
- 2. Allow the device to cool down and remove the mains plug from the mains socket.
- 3. Loosen the locking screw (3) on both sides of the device by turning in counter-clockwise direction.

4. Rotate the surface LED (2) to the desired position.



- 5. Tighten the locking screw (3) on both sides of the device.
- 6. Loosen the surface LED (2) together with the outer frame by turning the central locking screw (5) in counter-clockwise direction.
 - \Rightarrow You can now rotate the surface LED (2) together with the frame in both directions.





Info

The transport handle of the LED construction site spotlight and the surface LED can be rotated by up to 360°.

7. Lock the new position of the surface LED (2) by turning the central locking screw (5) in clockwise direction.

Operation

Tips and notes on handling the LED construction site spotlight

General information:

- Avoid looking directly into the light source.
- Use the devices only for a temporary illumination of indoor and outdoor areas, e.g. for construction sites.
- The LED construction site spotlights are particularly suited for illuminating larger areas.



Switching the device on

Please proceed as follows to switch the device on:

1. Check whether the power cable is plugged in correctly.

- 2. Set the on/off switch (7) to position I for the low brightness level or to position II for the high brightness level.
 - ⇒ The device switches on and the surface LED (2) lights up.



Shutdown

- Switch the device off by setting the on/off switch (7) to position 0.
- Hold onto the mains plug while pulling the power cable out of the mains socket.
- Allow the device to cool down.
- Clean the device according to the Maintenance chapter.
- Store the device according to the Storage chapter.

Errors and faults

The device has been checked for proper functioning several times during production. If malfunctions occur nonetheless, check the device according to the following list.

Troubleshooting tasks which require the housing to be opened must only be carried out by an authorized specialist electrical company or by Trotec.

The device is not lit:

- Check whether the power cable is connected correctly.
- Check the power cable and mains plug for damage. If you notice damages, do not try to take the device back into operation.

If the supply cord is damaged, it must be replaced by the manufacturer, its service agent or similarly qualified persons in order to avoid a hazard.

 The LEDs are defective. They cannot be replaced. Contact the Trotec customer service.

The overheating protection has tripped:

- 1. Remove the plug of the power cable from the mains socket and allow the device to cool down.
- 2. Investigate the cause of overheating.

Note

Wait for at least 3 minutes after maintenance and repair work. Only then switch the device back on.

The device still does not operate correctly after these checks:

Please contact the customer service. If necessary, bring the device to an authorised specialist electrical company or to Trotec for repair.

Cleaning

The device should be cleaned before and after each use.
